The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in this Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the International Jury, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1* The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the FAREAST 28R Class Rules, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto. Class Rules shall not be altered by the NOR or Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2* No national authority prescriptions apply
- 1.3 [DP] RRS 40.1 applies at all times while afloat
- 1.4 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, applies.
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.7 COVID-19 infection prevention
- 1.7.1 Infection prevention and hygienic regulations apply. The regulations will be published on the event website

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the event website www.fareast28rec.com from Mid August 2022 on. There will be no paper version available on the venue.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board at the EWVA Yachtclub (nr. 2 in Addendum A, the map of the event venue).
- 3.2** [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communication
- 3.3** [DP] On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF channel 8.
- 3.4** [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication which is not available to all boats.

4* [NP] [DP] ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1** The Regatta is open only to boats of the International FAREAST 28R class.
- 4.2** All boat owners or helmspersons (chartered boats) shall be members of the FAREAST 28R class association and the annual fee should be paid in good standing.
- 4.3** All boats shall carry a World Sailing One-Design class plaque. This might be purchased from FE28RICA.
- 4.4** Eligible boats shall enter **no later than 30 August 2022**. By completing the online entry form on the event website www.fareast28rec.com and paying the required fees.
- 4.5** The minimum number of entries for the class is as stated in the table in NoR 5.1. If a minimum number of entries in the class is not reached by 30 June 2022, the event may be cancelled by the OA.

5 FEES

- 5.1** Entry fees are as follows:

- 5.2** The entry fee includes launching and hauling by crane or slipway, parking of trailer and berthing for Thursday, Friday and Saturday night as well as dock party on Thursday and Saturday and class diner on Friday.
- 5.3** The fees are stated in Euro. Entries received not later than 30 April will qualify for the Early Entry Fee. Entries received between 01 May and 30 June will qualify for the Entry Fee. Entries between 01 July and 30 August will qualify for Late Entry Fee.

5.4 The entry fee shall be paid online upon completing the online entry form, even if the entry is cancelled later or the boat does not show up. The Entry Fee is non-refundable, except for the regatta or class being cancelled by the organizing authority or if the entry is rejected. The organizing authority may refund 80% of the entry fee due to withdrawal of the entry until 01 August 2022 and credible justification that the withdrawal is the result from an unpredictable COVID-19 situation.

5.5 Entries will not be valid until payment is received and confirmed by the OA.

6 CREW LIMITATIONS

6.1 The following crew limitations apply: crew weights must conform to the Class requirements.

7.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

- 13.1 The courses to be sailed will be Upwind Downwind
Also see NoR Addendum C the courses.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 14.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 14.2 The intention is to appoint an international jury as provided in RRS 70.5.

15 SCORING

15.1 Spare

15.2* Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

15.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

15.4 Spare

15.5 RRS 90.3(e) applies.

18 [DP] BERTHING

18.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour, marked in Addendum A as nr 7.

19 [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

19.1 Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

20 [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

20.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.

21 DATA PROTECTION

21.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22 RISK STATEMENT

- 22.1** RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 22.2** **The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.**

23 INSURANCE

- 23.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

24* PRIZES

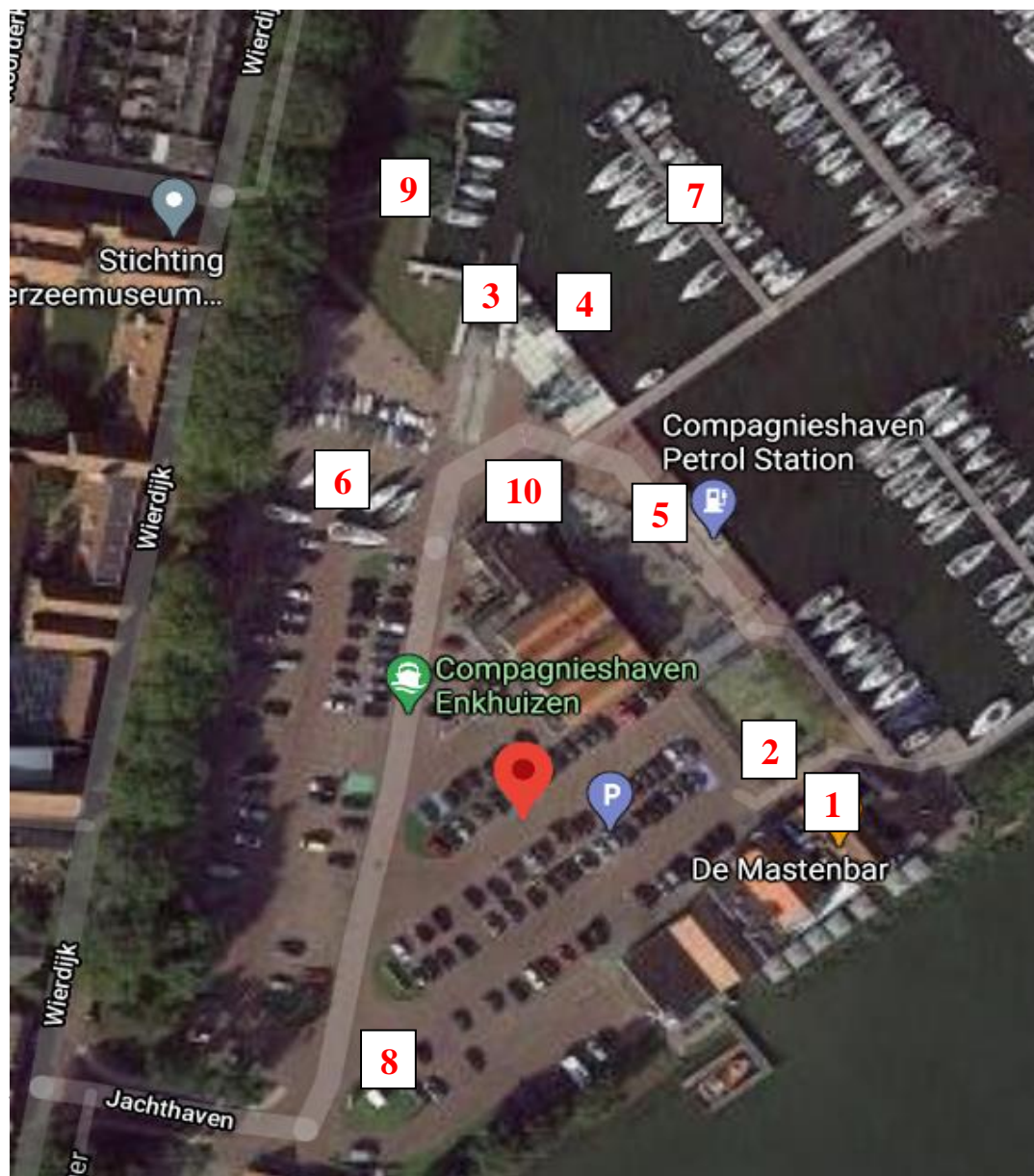
- 24.1** The European Championship Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner.

ADDENDUM B: THE MAP OF THE EVENT VENUE

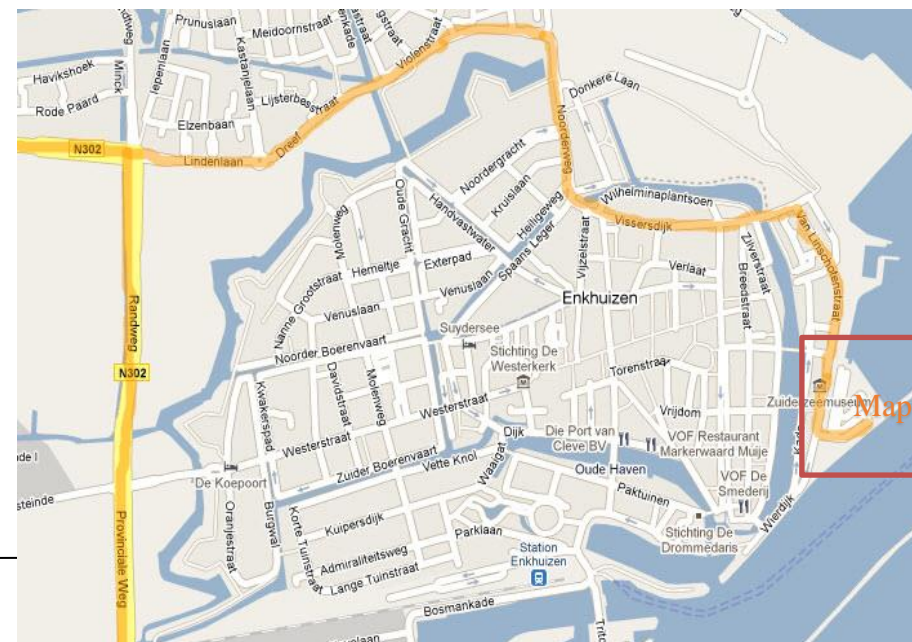


FAREAST 28R EC 2022

- 10 Harbor master office

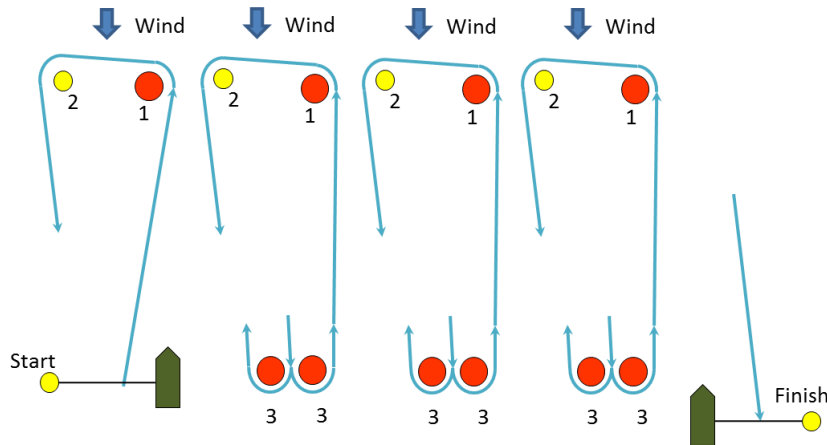
Route to Compagnieshaven Enkhuisen
