The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1* The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* .
- 1.2* For the Yngling and J-22, : The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' (available at [reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf](https://www.watersportverbond.nl/reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf) ([watersportverbond.nl](https://www.watersportverbond.nl)) will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.4* Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.
- 1.5 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, applies.



2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on 01st September 2022 at www.sportboatcup.nl

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board at the EWVA Yachtclub (nr. 2 in Addendum A, the map of the event venue).
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communication
- 3.3 [DP] On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHFchannel 8.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication which is not available to all boats.

4* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all One Design Sportboats classes.
 Currently confirmed classes:

- SB-20
- J80
- J-22 Open Dutch Championship
- Etchells
- Yngling Open Dutch Championship

As well as to all Sportboats with valid rating system certificates.

- 4.2 The rating system applies to boats racing under ORC Sportboat class

- 4.3 Classes are defined as follows:

- 4.4 Boats may enter the event by registering online before 20th August 2021 at: www.sportboatcup.nl

- 4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.



- 4.6** Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions:
Fulfilment of the standard fee plus 20 euro together with full registration, before the 01th September 2022

- 10.2** Boats may be inspected at any time. (Yngling and J-22 class only)
- 10.3** [DP] Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1 when presented for inspection.

- 14 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 15 SCORING**
- 15.1*** Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 15.2** (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When 5 , 6, 7 or 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 15.3** RRS 90.3(e) applies.
- 16 RESERVE**

- 18 [DP] BERTHING**
- 18.1** Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour, marked in Addendum A as nr 7.
- 19 [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**
- 19.1** Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.
- 20 [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS**



- 20.1** Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.
- 20.2** Keelboats shall not be cleaned below the waterline by any means from Saturday 10th 10.00 till Sunday 11th 16.00.

21 DATA PROTECTION

- 21.1** By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22 RISK STATEMENT

- 22.1** RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 22.2** **The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.**

23 INSURANCE

- 23.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

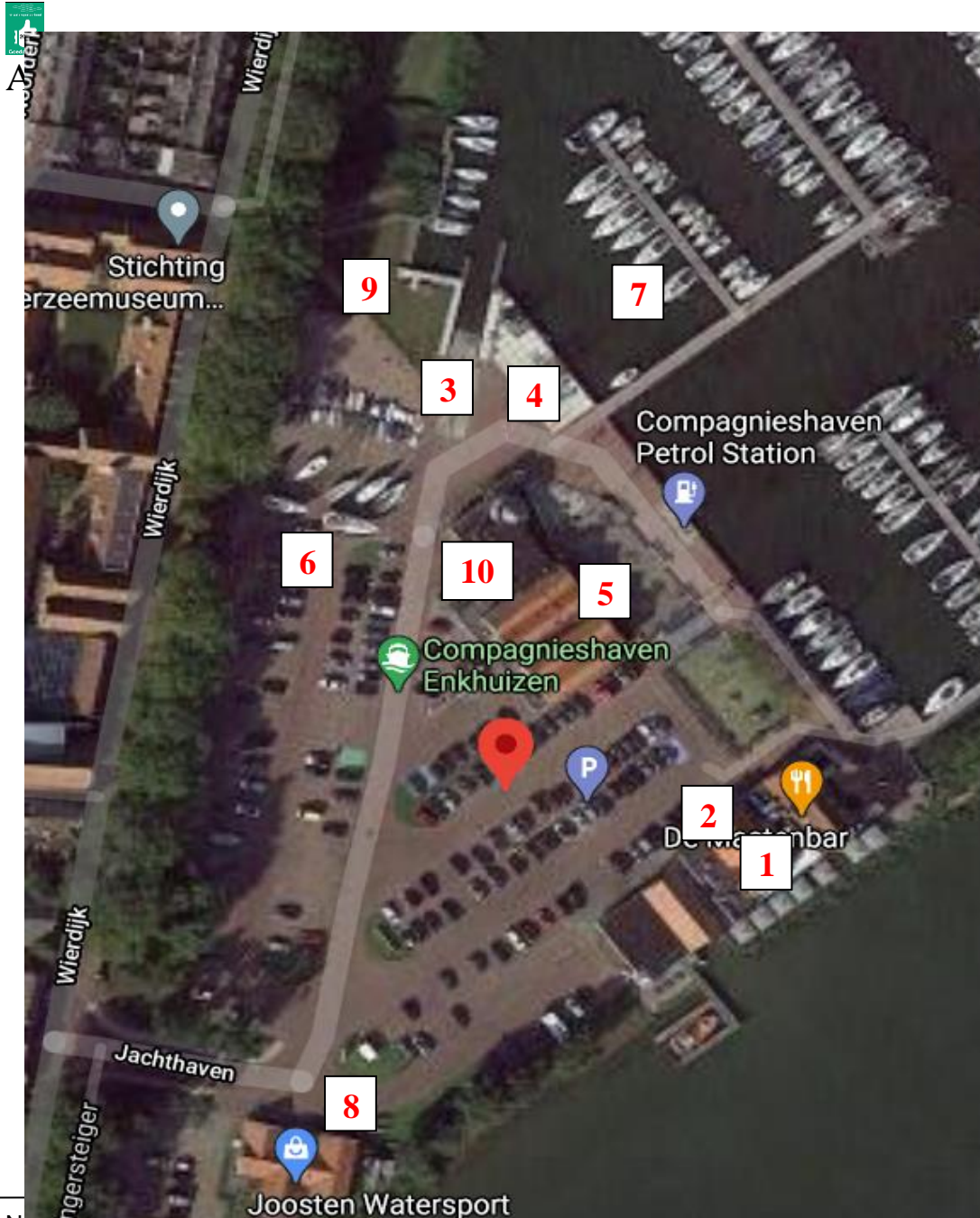
24* PRIZES

- 24.1** The RNWA supplies for the winning boat or team a blue pennant and a medal for every member of the crew of the first three boats or crews of the Yngling and J-22 class(there will be no extra medals available for changes in the crew during the event). Other prizes will be given as follows: First, Second and Third Prizes for every class.

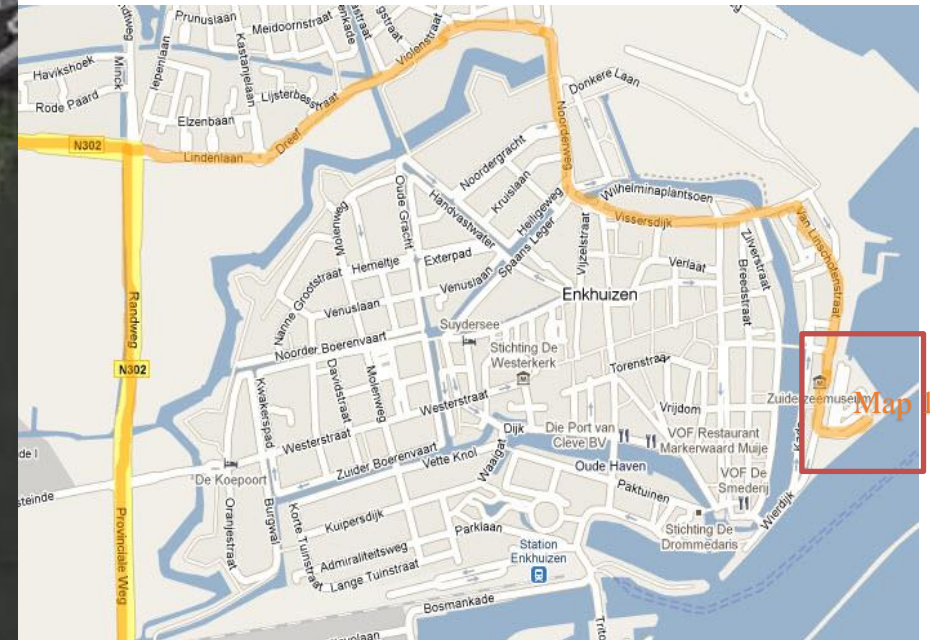
Addendum A: the map of the event venue
